However, he cautioned that the speed of passing vehicles may be faster under the bridge than outside the public house as it is closer to the unrestricted speed limit outside the village. Items 6a/b covered here: HBC and NYCC matters: Cllr Windass reported on both HBC and NYCC matters:

NYCC Elections: From 20 March to election on 4 May, purdah must be observed which means no information will be received by the County Councillors and candidates should not appear in the press.

HGV restrictions: At an area committee meeting Nigel Smith, Manager of Area 6, reported that progressing is being made on the implementation of the HGV restrictions through Boroughbridge and surrounding parishes.

Harrogate relief road: A survey showed that motorists travelling into the town were going into Harrogate not passing just passing through. The route of the relief road is still in debate. Kex Gill – Closures on the A59 due to land slips have resulted consideration of a new road to bypass Kex Gill.

Knaresborough Bond End Pollution: 6 schemes have been considered for the reduction of pollution in Bond End. 4 have been rejected of which one is to use mini roundabouts. This is the preferred scheme of the public.

Allerton Park Waste Recovery Park: At an Allerton Park liaison meeting last week Cllr Windass has requested more screening. Test burns are due in July.

Highways: Flooding on Cottage Lane has now been resolved but this has taken 2 years to get a positive result. Cllr Windass is confident that the Nigel Smith will be more proactive for future issues. Resurfacing of Skelton Road is another perennial problem. Cllr Windass to follow up. *Action: Cllr Windass*. The Parish Council has been informed that Cottage/Moor Lane becomes un-adopted north of Cottage Farm and NYCC are leaving it to deteriorate. The Parish Council feels this is unacceptable as it has previously been maintained by NYCC. Could Cllr Windass assist in investigating a way for NYCC to maintain this? *Action: Cllr Windass*. Plant leaving the building site on Leeming Lane has been leaving debris on the road which is washing into the drains. Regular cleaning will be provided during the building period.

There is an annual play area inspection by The Play Inspection Company and monthly checks by the Councillors. The Parish Council considers these to be sufficient assessed risks.

Increase due to improved efficiencies across the highways grass cutting service. Received and noted. Clerk to inform NYCC that the Parish Council would like to continue to carry out urban visibility grass cutting in Langthorpe. <u>Action: Clerk</u>
- c) Cottages
 - i) To receive an update on repairs in the cottages. Cllr Boswell reported that the work on the chimney stack needs scaffolding so waiting for good weather to complete. Tap in Holly Cottage bathroom still to repair. Roof of extension on Rose Cottage needs capping. Cllr Boswell to get quotation for this. *Action: Cllr Boswell*. All other jobs complete.
 - **ii)** To discuss the servicing of the cottage boilers Clerk was asked to investigate if the boilers at the same time of the year would lead to a discount in the cost. No discount would be available and to change one would mean a loss of 6 months cover for one of the cottages. No change is recommended.
- d) Milby Island To receive an update on the request to assist in the regeneration of Milby Island. A team has been convened to do various tasks on the island.
